## Hollywood Legends

Frank Worth, a freelance photographer in the 1940s and 1950s, belonged to an elite circle in Los Angeles and was a friend and confidante to many Hollywood stars. In honor of those close relationships, however, Worth did not publish many of his intimate pictures in his lifetime. It was only after his death in 2000 that his family found a treasure trove in Worth's home: exceptional photos showing Marilyn Monroe, James Dean, Frank Sinatra, Elizabeth Taylor and many more silver screen legends. From March 26 through May 16, the Amerika Haus will present a comprehensive selection of Worth's photos for the first time in Germany. Admission to the exhibition is free. <<<


## Dorothea Prühl

Gold, silver, wood, aluminum, titanium and stainless steel are the preferred materials of jewelry designer Dorothea Prühl. Born in 1937 in Breslau, Prühl is one of Germany's leading jewelry artists. Her aesthetic language is characterized by a focus on the essential, an exceptional plastic strength and abstract impressions of nature.

A flower, a house and even mere wind inspire her fragile designs. From March 14 through May 15, the Pina-  
kothek der Moderne will present a comprehensive overview of Prühl's work. The exhibition will be on display in the design section. <<<

## Maison Martin Margiela

Belgian designer Martin Margiela is one of the rare figures in the hectic fashion world, who shuns the spotlight. Margiela has never had his picture taken and never appears to the audience at his fashion shows. Accordingly, products of Maison Martin Margiela's (MMM) label bear no logo. Only a simple white rectangle sewn with four corner stitches to the inside of the garment mark creations by Margiela, who previously assisted Jean-Paul Gaultier. To celebrate the 20th anniversary of the Belgian designer's discreet trademark, the Haus der Kunst will present a retrospective of his most outstanding designs. Along with Margiela's tailoring, part of the exhibition will be dedicated to boutiques of MMM and the special treatment of work space: When Margiela moves into new offices, he takes over the furnishings of the previous inhabitants and paints them white to create the impression of frozen time. The unique fashion and design show will be on display from March 20 through June 1. <<<


